#### Benicia Middle School Color Guard 2019-2020

Welcome to the award-winning Benicia Middle School Color Guard! This is going to be a fun and exciting year, with a jam-packed parade season and competitive Winter Guard! This packet is intended to give you a general idea of what to expect for the upcoming season, along with supply lists!

# What is Color Guard?

Color Guard, known as "The Sport of the Arts," is a dance-based activity in which students learn a choreographed dance and prop routine to music. Incorporating styles of Jazz, Modern, and Ballet with the use of Flags, Rifles, Shields, and Sabres, the choreography and show design operates as the "visual enhancement" to the music performed by the marching band. In Winter Guard, the students perform a longer routine to recorded music in a more theatrical setting (indoors performances.)

Benicia has a long-standing history of success, which requires a full commitment mentally and physically from performing members. *As this is a synchronized activity, it is imperative that all students attend every rehearsal in order to learn technique, consistency, and how to be a team player.* This activity relies on the work of all students equally, and in order to achieve success we must all commit to giving 110% of our efforts at all times.

<u>Competitions are Mandatory.</u> If a student must leave early and be picked up by an guardian, a note must be given to Jamie, Candice, Jason or Shirley prior to the date of the competition who will relay the information to the head chaperone.

#### ATTENDANCE POLICY:

ATTITUDE, ATTENDANCE, and ABILITY make up the 3 components to a successful program. Attitude makes up 70% of success, while Attendance makes up 20%, and natural Ability is 10%. This is important to realize as we strive for success.

- 2 Unexcused Tardies = 1 Unexcused Absence
- 3 Unexcused Absences = Cut from the team

Excused Absence examples: Illness, family emergency, Once-In-A-Lifetime events that have been previously cleared by the staff, etc.

Unexcused Absence examples: Homework (time-management is important), B-Day parties, minor illness with no communication.

Parents, please attempt to schedule any medical/dental appointments outside of our rehearsal time if at all possible. It is understandable that sometimes this cannot be done, but with a large group of students and 2 staff members, it is essential that we all do our best to be at every rehearsal. The main point is that communication is important and I'll try to be flexible when you are communicating with me. Excused absences must be cleared 24 HOURS in advance. If you are sick, your parent must contact me (Jamie) via e-mail or phone before rehearsal.

### **ACADEMIC POLICY:**

In order to participate in the Benicia Middle School Color Guard, you must maintain a 2.0 GPA and pass all classes with at least a "C" or better. Grade checks will be performed bi-quarterly. If you are failing in a class, you will be put on probation, and will be required to show weekly progress reports until the next grading period. At that point if you are still not able to meet the minimum expectations, you will no longer be able to participate with the Color Guard. If improvement is apparent, your participation may continue. I strongly suggest that you bring all homework to rehearsals and study with your guard family to keep your grades up!

#### DRESS CODE:

Color Guard dress attire must be flexible dancewear, preferably form-fitting. Black tights with shorts, jazz pants, basketball shorts, etc. are acceptable. We must be able to see the lines that your body creates, please avoid loose, baggy clothing such as sweats or pajama pants if possible. If the weather calls for something otherwise, exceptions will be made. Dance/athletic shoes are required at all practices. Students may wear split-sole jazz performance shoes during rehearsal. Rehearsals that are indoors will be barefoot on the floor, as we use a take on the Modern Dance Technique. Hair must be pulled back and out of face at all times for safety reasons. Ponytails, buns, headbands etc. are all acceptable for rehearsal.

<u>During Competition Season</u>: Students in uniform are not permitted to have any visible piercings or hair color. Please plan accordingly. I try to be more flexible during winter season, depending on the theme.

# **COMPETITION PREP:**

For Marching competitions, the girls will arrive at the school with make-up and hair done but will need all the items with them for touch ups. They will also need to have on their white leotard, nylons, white socks, blue briefs, blue zippered sweatshirt and black sweats.

We will be purchasing some for student use, though having your own equipment is highly recommended.)

**Purchase on your own:** Black dance/yoga pants (form-fitting to the leg, shorts with black tights OK), Guard Bag (Duffel bag to hold tape, snacks, water, rehearsal clothes), 1 Roll White Electric Tape at all times, 1Roll Black Electric Tape at all times, Sun Block, Hair Ties/Bobby Pins, Water at all times & Healthy snacks for break time.
